We continue to collaborate with various community organizations to offer educational opportunities to underprivileged students in Africa and other developing countries.

The organization welcomed new board members and volunteer staff, bringing new perspectives and ideas, while also saying goodbye to some of our guiding guiding lights. Despite these changes, our core values of serving with conscience and sensitivity have remained constant and have helped us navigate all challenges with courage.

Pilot scholarship program

Our pilot scholarship program in Ghana received around 200 applications, from which we selected 4 students based on their essays, interviews, and WAEC scores.

The program continues to offer complete financial support for a four-year college education, covering tuition and housing costs, and providing scholars with laptops.

Additionally, scholars have access to internship and mentorship opportunities through the Force For Health Network.





Force for Health

The Force for Health Network is a student powered, mixed media, gamification platform specifically designed to motivate individuals and leaders to MOVE, LEARN, SERVE and EARN their way towards points and giveaways for themselves, their families and their communities. It also encourages users to promote good health in their communities and become a "Force for Health" in their own lives and those around them.

EduCom has sustained its partnership with Force for Health and has introduced the mobile application to schools and colleges in Ghana. Our four scholars, wh o are studying medicine have reported that the appli cation has been beneficial to them, in their studies.





Borehole Commissioning

On 11th June, CEO Lawrence Owusu Fianko, Board member Veronica Samoa Owusu and CFO Joseph Hamelo represented EduCom to commission a borehole at Graceland Shelter Orphanage in Adom Fie Ghana, West Africa, where we successfully commissioned a borehole that serves both the orphanage and the community at large.











Fundraiser Gala




